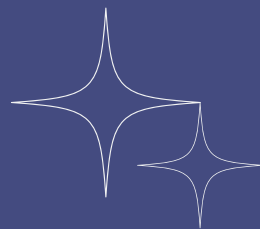


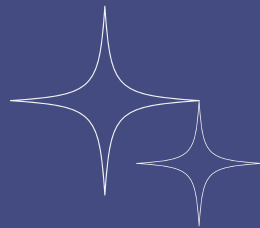
ZAINAL ABIIDIN

Zainal Abidin, a true legend in Singapore's sporting history, is an eleven-time Squash National Champion, and has represented Singapore in a multitude of prestigious World Squash Championships. From 1980 to 1989, he maintained his status as an Asia-wide champion, showcasing his exceptional skills on the global stage. Beyond his extensive collection of individual medals and both national and international titles, including impressive wins like the Japan Open in 1985 and 1986, he admirably carried Singapore's flag to victory in the World Championships – contributing to Singapore's ranking as the world number 6 at the 1985 World Championships in Cairo. His achievements extended to Asian Championships, where he secured a notable second place in 1986, as well as victories in the East Asia Championships, dominating the field since 1979 and maintaining this dominance for years to come. Zainal's triumphs reached far and wide, spanning the SEA Games and beyond.



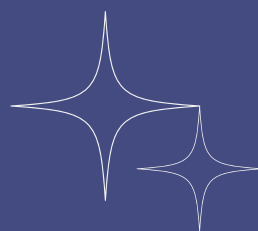
TIMOTHY ARNOLD

ELVINN KEO

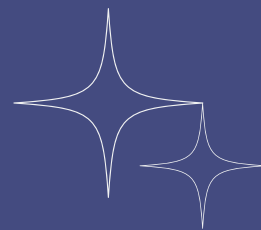

JAMIE

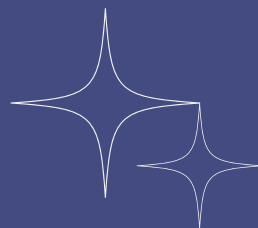
